B.S. in Business Administration

B.S. in Business Administration (with a single or dual concentration) prepares you to assume a career in business management, information systems and business analytics, financial management, marketing or management. All students enjoy engaged and supportive faculty, a challenging curriculum and small interactive classes (approximately 30-50 students once you enter your major), in one or more of these business disciplines.

B.S. in Accounting

B.S. in Accounting gives you essential competency in financial accounting, managerial accounting, auditing taxation and accounting information systems, complemented by studies in other areas of business and economics. After completing the 120 credits required for graduation, many students choose to move directly on to graduate accounting studies at the School of Business in order to prepare for a Certificate of Public Accountancy.

B.S. in Digital Forensics

B.S. in Digital Forensics is the first of its kind in New York State and is one of only a handful in the entire nation. Digital forensics is a fast-growing billion-dollar market, with high long-term projected demand for trained professionals. Students learn how to follow digital "fingerprints" left behind in incidents of identity theft, insider trading, cyber attacks, industrial espionage and terrorism. Digital forensic scientists are able to investigate incidents and track activities in the electronic domain.
