Undergraduate Admission Available

The University at Albany offers conditional undergraduate admission to applicants who meet the academic requirements but not the English proficiency requirement.

Through conditional admissions, students who complete level Advanced 2 of the **Intensive English Language Program (IELP)** at University at Albany will be able to meet the English proficiency requirement. Students who successfully complete the IELP will receive a TOEFL/IELTS waiver.

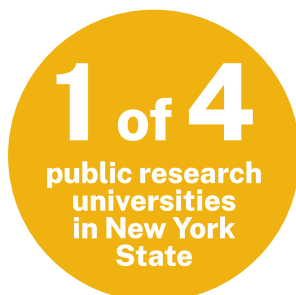
