**Undergraduate admission available**

The University at Albany offers conditional undergraduate admission to applicants who meet the academic requirements but not the English proficiency requirement. Through conditional admissions, students who complete Level Advanced 2 of the Intensive English Language Program (IELP) at the University at Albany will be able to meet the English proficiency requirement. Students who successfully complete the IELP will receive a TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo waiver.
