

2018 Artists of the Mohawk Hudson Region October 11 – December 8, 2018

The Regional

The 2018 Artists of the Mohawk Hudson Region Juried Exhibition will be held October 11 through December 8, 2018 at the University Art Museum, University at Albany. This annual exhibition is collaboratively sponsored by the University Art Museum, the Albany Institute of History & Art, and The Hyde Collection, Glens Falls.

Eligibility

The exhibition is open to artists residing within a 100-mile radius of the Capital Region. Works in all media that have been completed in the past 3 years are eligible. Works must be available for this exhibition. Works previously exhibited in Mohawk Hudson Regionals are not eligible.

Juror

Jean Shin has exhibited at more than 150 museums and cultural institutions, including solo exhibitions at the Museum of Modern Art, New York; the Fabric Workshop and Museum, Philadelphia; the Smithsonian American Art Museum, Washington, DC; and the Philadelphia Museum of Art. She recently completed a landmark commission, *Elevated*, for the New York City's new Second Avenue Subway.

Recognizing the concealed potential of everyday objects, Shin takes forgotten and discarded items and reinvigorates them through deconstruction and reassembly. Generating vast installations that comment on consumerism, hope, and transformation, she often solicits materials from the community in which the work is installed, creating compelling expressions of identity through social exchange.

On-line Submission Procedure

Submissions are limited to 5 works. Artists may submit up to 5 representative images of artwork in jpg format (10mb max), up to 3 video works (or excerpts) in mp4 format, totaling no more than 10 minutes in length, a brief artist statement (maximum 250 words), a resume, and entry fee. Installation artists may submit proposals and drawings in jpg or pdf format, keeping in mind the museum's space limitations (door widths, wall heights, etc.) and bear all installation costs. Call the museum to discuss limitations before submission of written proposals.

After entering your personal information and uploading images and attachments, click "Submit". A payment form for the entry fee will follow. If you need assistance, please call the museum at 518-442-4035.

Entry Fee

A non-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 will be charged to assist with exhibition costs.

Entry Dates

Online submissions: June 13 through July 13, 2018.

Delivery of Work

Artists will be expected to deliver their artwork to the University Art Museum on Monday, September 24 (10 am - 5 pm) or Tuesday, September 25 (10 am - 7 pm). Artwork must be suitably framed or mounted (no exposed glass edges) with hanging wire securely attached to the frame. The University Art Museum reserves the right not to accept any artwork in fragile or unstable condition and to improve upon hanging devices if necessary.

Juror Selection

Notifications of works selected will be emailed by Friday, August 17, 2018. The decisions of the juror are final.

Reception

A Reception and Awards Ceremony will be hosted at the University Art Museum on Friday, October 19, from 5 pm to 8 pm. The Awards Ceremony is scheduled for 6:30 pm.

Purchase Awards

One or more purchases are made by the University Art Museum, the Albany Institute of History & Art, and The Hyde Collection for their museums' collections.

Juror's Awards

Cash and gift certificate awards, sponsored by regional art patrons, will be selected by the juror.

Invitational Exhibition

An invitational exhibition will be drawn from 2018 Artists of the Mohawk Hudson Region and presented at the Albany Center Gallery.

Catalogue

An illustrated catalogue with an essay by the juror will be published by the University Art Museum and will be available during the exhibition.

Liability

Submission of images for judging constitutes an agreement by the artist to the conditions of this prospectus. It is understood that entering the Regional indicates that the University Art Museum is authorized to photograph, and/or reproduce in any media any accepted work for purposes, including, but not limited to, catalogue, website, educational, publicity, and marketing for this exhibition only. All work selected for this exhibition will be insured by the University Art Museum for the duration of the exhibition. All reasonable care will be exercised in the handling of the works received. The University Art Museum will not act as an agent for work offered for sale nor will a commission be taken in the event of sale.

Removal of Work

Removal dates for exhibited works are: Friday, December 14 (10 am - 5 pm) or Saturday December 15 (10 am - 1 pm).
